Maths

Right Angles: making different sized angles; drawing triangles and quadrilaterals and identifying vertices; learning about right angles, rectangles, squares and different polygons involving right angles.

Manipulating the additive relationship and securing mental calculation: adding two 3-digits numbers using partitioning and adjusting; adding a pair of 2-or 3-digit numbers using redistribution; subtracting 2- or 3-digit numbers; accurately and efficiently solving multi-step addition and subtraction problems and rearranging equations ready for solving.

Column addition: to identify the addends in an addition equation and then learning to use the column addition method effectively to solve problems.

2, 4 and 8 times tables: learning to count in 2's, 4's and 8's; recognising the relationship between the different multiples; and using the divisibility rules for divisors of 2, 4 and 8 to solve problems. Column subtraction: to identify the minuend and subtrahend and learning to use the column subtraction method effectively to solve problems.

English

Our Focus Text this Term is Shadow Forest, Escape from Pompeii, Non-fiction texts about Volcanoes and eruptions, A pebble in my pocket and Journey. Narrative focusing on the setting, shape poems in the form of a volcano, newspaper report based on Escape from Pompeii, playscripts linked to our Easter Production, non-chronological report about the Earth's Crust and an information guide about our local area and Ben Nevis.

Mighty Mountains and Extreme Earth

Geography and History

Looking at the topographical features of Oxford and how it has changed over time as well as exploring the power of nature through volcanoes, earthquakes, and tsunamis. Exploring the physical and human geography that surrounds Ben Nevis- Tallest Mountain in the UK. Using a range of geographical skills and fieldwork to plot mountains and draw maps showing a range of human and physical features.

Discover what the Ring of Fire is and how they link up to the tectonic plates that form part of their existence. Delve into historic events such as the Earthquakes in Italy and how it has had an impact on the civilisation that surround it.
