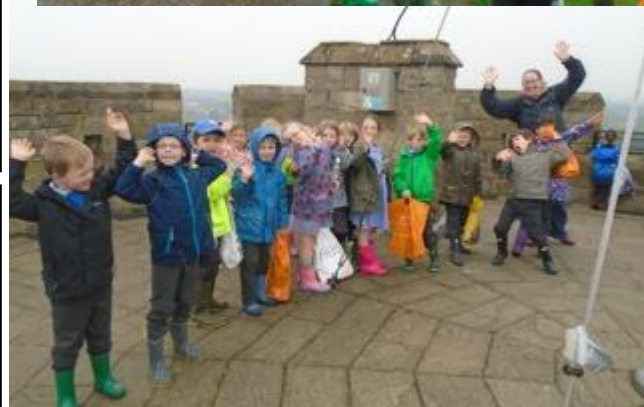

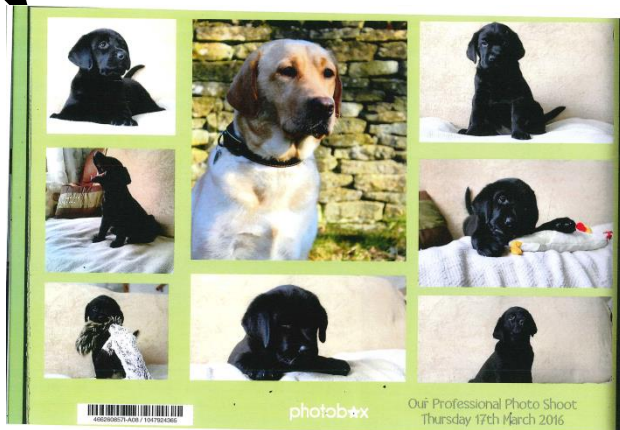

## School Dog – Yellow Labrador, Brenda

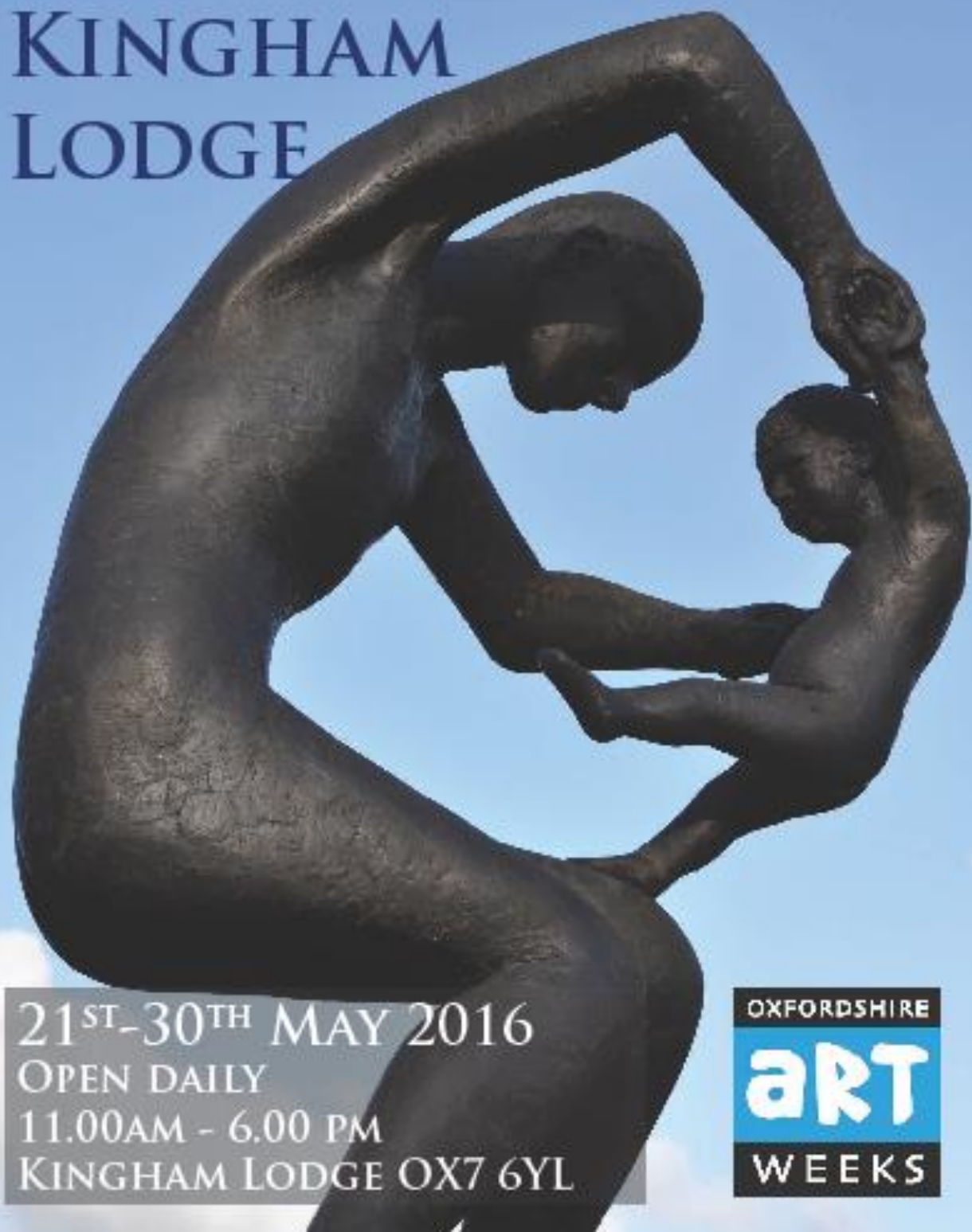
