

Mathematics

Counting in 2's, 3's, 5's, and 10's.

Fractions: $\frac{1}{2}$, $\frac{2}{4}$, $\frac{1}{3}$, $\frac{1}{4}$, $\frac{3}{4}$. Finding halves and quarters of amounts and counting in fractions.

Multiplication and division. Exploring the inverse relationship and using this to solve mathematical probs.

Naming and describing properties of 3D shapes.

Telling the time to nearest 5 mins: analogue and digital.

Place value addition using 100's, tens and ones. Using money and giving change.

Collecting and handling data.

Science

Uses of everyday materials.

Identify and compare the suitability of everyday materials for particular purposes.

Find out how the shapes of some solid objects can be changed.

Literacy

Grammar: nouns, adjectives, verbs, past and present tense, connectives, plurals, types of sentences.

Punctuation: Capital letters, full stops, question and exclamation marks, use of commas in lists, apostrophes to show ownership and for shortened words.

Vocabulary and spelling: prefix and suffixes, words ending in ment, less, ly, tion, dge, ge, ff, ss, ll, tch, le, el, all and al.

Homophones.

Dictionary skills and proof reading to check for errors.

Reading: Talk about and give opinions on a range of texts. Read for meaning and check that text makes sense. Draw inference from text and illustrations. Read with expression and intonation.

Factual and narrative writing based upon Hist, Geog and Science topics.
