*She will be talking to years 1 & 2 about her books from the 'Stunt Bunny' series.*

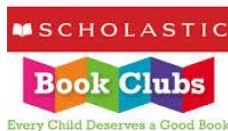
*She will bring a selection of her books, which will be available for sale. Please see the flyer sent home with your child today.*
