

MATHS

Multiplication and Division

Multiplying numbers up to 4 digits by a 1 digit or 2 digit number using a formal written method, including long multiplication.

Dividing 4 digits by 1 digit using short division.

Problem solving including the use of factors, multiples, square and cube numbers, scaling by simple fractions and problems involving simple rates.

Fractions

Converting mixed numbers and improper fractions.

Equivalent fractions.

Comparing and ordering fractions.

Adding and subtracting fractions

Multiplying proper fractions and mixed numbers by whole numbers.

Reading and writing fractions as decimals.

Reading, writing, comparing, ordering and rounding decimals.

Recognising the percent symbol. Writing percentages as a fraction and as a decimal.

SCIENCE

Multiplication and Division

We will be learning about the life cycle of birds, insects, amphibians and mammals. We will learn to describe the differences between different life cycles. We will learn about the process of reproduction in both plants and animals and create a timeline to indicate the stages of growth in humans.

ART & DESIGN

Through our history project including the Suffragette movement, we will learn about the history of posters produced at the time and design and paint our own Suffragette poster art in the style of the time.

This term, we will be learning about the journey through history from absolute monarchy to absolute democracy. We will begin by learning about parliament and democracy today including our British Values.

We will then go back to a time of absolute democracy. We will learn about the Feudal System, the Magna Carta, the English Civil War and the execution of King Charles I. We will learn about the Suffragette movement and the vote for women. We will end our topic with a visit from our local MP, Robert Courts.

MUSIC

Music lessons will be provided by the Oxfordshire County Music Service. The children will learn to play a brass instrument.

RE

Baptism

We will learn about the story of the Baptism of Jesus and recall some actions that take place at Baptism. We will learn about the signs, symbols and actions in the Sacrament of Baptism.

Parables and Sayings of Jesus

We will recall some of Jesus' teachings in the Parables. We will learn about the image of the church as the Kingdom of God.

Lent

We will learn about Lent being an important season in the Church year and being a season of change. We will learn about the Sacrament of Reconciliation and of God's forgiveness of sin.

Holy Week

We will recall the events of Jesus' final week. We will discuss reasons why others wanted to kill Jesus. We will learn about the story of the Passover and recognise links between this story, the Last Supper and the celebration of Mass.

ENGLISH

Fiction

- We will learn to write our own newspaper report about the execution of Charles I in 1649 during the English Civil War.

Poetry

- A walk through Holy Week at springtime.

Non-Fiction

- We will write a formal letter to our local MP, Mr Robert Courts, asking him to visit us in school.
- We will write a book review about a book that we read from last term's 'The Book Trust's 100 Best Books' challenge.

COMPUTING

We will use Scratch Geometry to learn how to reflect, rotate and translate shapes.

We will learn how to produce a slideshow using Google Slides.

FRENCH

We will learn to express likes/dislikes of different sporting activities in French. We will learn the vocabulary for different foods, locating words in a bilingual dictionary and learn to express likes/dislikes. We will learn to pronounce the numbers 1-50. We also memorise and present a short rhyme.

PE

Through lessons in rugby, we will learn passing skills as well as tactics for attacking and defending. We will learn to gain possession by working as a team.

Through orienteering lessons, we will learn to read a simple map, use clues and a compass to navigate a route. We will learn to use new information to change our route.
